## GOOD SAMARITAN BILL

We have just received word from state that Governor Riley has agreed to include the Good Samaritan bill in the Call for the special session next week. When state AIA met with the legislative liaisons two weeks ago, they made the case that it would be good public policy for the state especially with us in the midst of hurricane season. State AIA stressed that this legislation would not represent any financial gain for our profession, as we would be providing critical services at no charge.

The session is tentatively scheduled to begin next Tuesday and conclude within five legislative days. The House and Senate leadership have said they only plan to consider legislation in the Governor’s call and local bills. If a bill is not in the Call, it must have a 3/5 vote to pass a chamber, as opposed to a simple majority for bills in the Call.

This is great news for our profession as we have been requesting this for some time.
